Advent Lectio Divina

There are four scripture passages for each week of Advent (one for Christmas Eve or Day), so even if a day is missed or if you want to spend more than one day on a particular scripture, you will not get behind. Follow these five steps as you approach each scripture.

- 1. **Lectio** (reading, listening): Read the text once or twice. What does the text say to me? What word or phrase catches my attention?
- 2. **Meditatio** (meditation): Reflect silently on the text and listen. What is God saying to me through the text? What words, images, and insights arise? How does this reading connect with something in my life?
- 3. *Oratio* (prayer): Talk to God about your thoughts and feelings. Be honest, especially about your fear and anxiety. What do I want to say to God about the text? What do I hear God saying to me?
- 4. **Contemplatio** (contemplation): Be still and rest in the presence of God who has offered God's Word through this prayer experience.
- 5. **Actio** (action): How am I called to conversion based on this time of prayer? What is the Spirit calling me to do today?
